

Who is RDA?

Riding for the Disabled Association of Singapore (RDA Singapore) is the only registered charity in Singapore which provide free therapeutic and rehabilitative horse-riding for children and adults with disabilities. Over the past 33 years, we have helped over 6000 beneficiaries.

What we do?

We provide horse-riding therapy (hippotherapy) to those with special needs. Hippotherapy has proven to help those with physical disability like cerebral palsy with improved muscle tone, motor functions and coordination. For those with learning disability like autism, we have seen improved social skills and better sensory sensitivity.

Unlike most therapies conducted in clinical or hospital setting, we bring our riders out for 'jungle walk' to a nearby forested trail. For many of our riders with physical disabilities, going into a forest is almost impossible on a wheelchair or walking aid. But they can do so with ease on a horse-back.

Over the years, we have seen some of our riders advancing beyond therapy riding to competition level and even to the Paralympics! Two of our riders, Gemma Foo and Maximillian Tan represented Singapore in the 2012 London Paralympics started their riding sessions here at RDA Singapore.

Can I or my child sign up for the hippotherapy session?

If you or your child is 6 years old or older, weigh no more than 60kg (132lb) and have a physical, intellectual or learning disability, you can register with us via www.rdasingapore.org/Equine-Assisted-Therapy/RDA-Singapore
