RDA THERAPEUTIC RIDING PROGRAMME

RDA Singapore is the only charity in Singapore that provides Equine-Assisted Therapy free-of-charge to disabled adults and children. The range of disabilities that can benefit from equine-assisted therapy include: Physical disabilities such as Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophy, Visual & Hearing Impairment, CVA (Stroke), Cognitive & Intellectual disabilities such as Down's Syndrome and Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Horses provide a tool for physical therapy and cognitive improvement in a unique format that is fun and exhilarating. There is also a centuries-old belief that horses have the power to change a person's perspective on life. Besides the physical benefits derived from equine-assisted therapy, the contact with the animal is a powerful experience, and the strong bond that can be formed often has a profound and uplifting effect.

During the reporting period from 1 April 2016 to 31 March 2017, a total of 480 persons with various disabilities were assisted under RDA Singapore's Therapeutic Riding Programme, exceeding the NCSS target of 380 by 27%!
