# CHARITY TRANSPARENCY AWARD

RDA Singapore was humbled and honoured to once again receive the **CHARITY TRANSPARENCY AWARD** (CTA) - we are among 15 medium sized charities recognised for exemplary disclosure and transparency practices. This is the second consecutive year that we won the award!

All registered charities - on meeting the Award's eligibility criteria - would automatically be assessed on nine areas of disclosure, recommended under the Charity Transparency Framework (CTF), which is closely aligned to the Code of Governance for Charities and Institutions of a Public Character (IPCs).

The Awards Presentation Ceremony was held on 29 Nov 2018, at Flower Field Hall, Gardens by The Bay.

# RDA PROGRAM UPDATES

During the last financial year, we served 381 beneficiaries - 208 riders from SPED Schools & VWOs and 173 individual riders, meeting the NCSS - Enhanced Program Evaluation System's annual target of 380 beneficiaries.

98%	OF OUR BENEFICIARIES ACHIEVED BASIC IMPROVEMENT IN PSYCHO-SOCIAL FUNCTIONING
84%	OF OUR BENEFICIARIES ACHIEVED ADVANCE IMPROVEMENT IN PSYCHO-SOCIAL FUNCTIONING
96%	OF OUR BENEFICIARIES ACHIEVED BASIC IMPROVEMENT IN PHYSICAL MOTOR FUNCTIONING

# RDA OUTCOMES TRACKER

In 2018, a pilot trial of the *RDA OUTCOMES TRACKER* was expanded to all sessions.

The Tracker is a simple to use holistic tool, to track and provide evidence of the changes and therapeutic outcomes that are delivered through riding. The Tracker shows at a glance where and how much change has taken place during a period of riding. Change is measured in six different areas. These areas are *Communication, Confidence, Enjoyment, Relationships, Physical Changes* and *Horsemanship*.

Insights from the Tracker can help identify future targets and goals – with RDA instructors and volunteers able to tailor lessons and activities accordingly. The results can then be shared with family, carers, schools, etc. - not only providing the opportunity for a rider to share their achievements but also for others to build on any therapeutic changes outside RDA sessions.

Working with the Tracker encourages volunteers to be more observant and engage more closely with riders. It also encourages volunteers to feel included and gives them a sense of purpose and value Results from the pilot trial, out of 198 beneficiaries (that completed a 10weeks program):

- **80%** showed a greater willingness and ability to Communicate
- 82% displayed greater Confidence
- 87% experienced more Enjoyment
- 84% showed improved Relationship building skills
- 84% demonstrated Physical improvement
- 79% demonstrated advances in Horsemanship
