(B) RIDERS SPONSORSHIP

Every year, some 20 SPED schools & VWOs ride with RDA Singapore. Riders profile ranges from those with intellectual, cognitive, developmental and/or physical disabilities. Each batch consists of 12 riders with special needs, each rider will undergo a ~10week term of horse-riding therapy with RDA. We are looking for sponsors to help us off-set the costs of running our therapy program. **SPONSORING A BATCH OF 12 RIDERS (X ~10 SESSIONS): \$12,000**

(C) HORSE SPONSORSHIP

Our horses play a huge role in providing the unique Equine-Assisted Activities & Therapeutic Horse-Riding program for persons with disabilities. 
